

RAC Karri Valley Resort (Environmental Industries)

Contract 4225 PO069873 (2020)

Follow design and construct ring roads through carpark. Construct hard stands for caravans. Bitumise designated areas, round-abouts, car parks etc. Cover batter with top soils. Concrete kurb surrounding areas and install fencing.



Main Roads: Albany Highway (Highway Construction)

Contract 197-18-0017 Albany-Muir Highway Shoulder Sealing (Jan 2021 to April 2022)

176kms of full shoulder widening. Boxing out to 200mm, topping up with side tippers and new material. Seal.



Bridgetown Skate Park (Environmental Industries)

Contract 0215-02-PE (2021)

Construct concrete bowls, ramps, carparks. Landscape as designed and install reticulation.



Main Roads: Coolgardie/Esperance (Highway Construction)

Contract 116-19 Project C116/19 Coolgardie/Esperance Upgrade (May 2021 to December 2022)

50km of full road design and construct. Cut and fill. Install drainage and batters. Lift pit material for base coarse and top coat. Condition materials and deliver to site.

Main Roads: Bussel Highway (Highway Construction)

Contract C197.18-0017 (June 2021 to January 2022)

50km from Carbenup to Margaret River of shoulder widening. Boxing out to 200mm, topping up with side tippers and new material. Seal.



Main Roads: Wongan Hills (Highway Construction)

Contract M056 Calingiri - Wongan Hills (2022)

Work along stabiliser doing patch work. Full overlay of seal from Great Northern Hwy to Wongan Hills.



Main Roads: Great Eastern Highway Upgrade (Highway Construction)

Contract GEH-Walgoolan 197-18-0027 (July 2022 to July 2023)

Full demolition and reconstruction of bridge at Walgoolan and bridge widening at Morine Rock. Partnered with ALBUM. All embankment and approaches have been completed at Morine Rock and we are currently doing embankment lifts and approaches at Walgoolan. Demolition to begin shortly.



DFES and Local Shire: Fire Mitigation

Contract 166116 (ongoing)

Providing services to DFES and local shires for mitigation works as requested. This includes heavy duty slashing, mulching and installing and maintaining firebreaks.

Full road reconstruction using stabilisers and grader to face up and trim.

Sub-contracting for Yirdiya Pty Ltd/ Garli.


Widening and sealing of the highway and stabilisation of floodways between Nanutarra-Munjina Road to Roebourne-Wittenoom Road.
